Letterbook contained business correspondence of M. Faler and business and personal correspondence of Andrew Mangold, member of the firm. Business letters concern the purchase and sale of goods, the condition of cotton crops, cotton picking, insurance, freight, prices and other related matters. A few personal letters to Andrew Mangold concerning the Hazelhurst Church, camp meetings, and the Hazelhurst Opera House, along with letters from his brother, are included.
