**Summary** This collection contains negatives and photographs taken by

Albert C. Bacon, circa 1919-1963. Photographic subjects cover Baton Rouge, the Mississippi River, LSU campus, chemical plants and oil refineries, local parades, and area flooding circa 1950. Writings include an account of Bacon's service as a United States Marine in France during World War I. Printed materials include Baton Rouge postcards, LSU ephemera, Delta Zeta publications,

and a scrapbook about Huey P. Long.

#### **BIOGRAPHICAL/HISTORICAL NOTE**

Albert Chester Bacon (December 14, 1894 - May 19, 1974) was a World War I veteran, photographer, and musician from Baton Rouge, Louisiana. He was born in Leavittsburg, Ohio, the oldest of three children. His parents were Asa Falkner Bacon (1860-1930) and Minta Hassenplugh Bacon (1864-1938). Bacon's sister Gladys Lenora Bacon Hightower (1897-1925) was also born in Ohio. His younger brother, Oliver Hassenplugh Bacon (1906-1993) was born in McKesport, Pennsylvania. The Bacon family lived in Pennsylvania until Albert graduated high school, circa 1912-1913. The family moved to Baton Rouge circa 1914-1915. Albert Bacon enrolled at Louisiana State University in the College of Agriculture in 1915. He attended classes at the downtown campus and was a musician in the LSU Band.

Bacon enlisted for military service soon after the United States entered WWI, in May or June 1917. He served with the 75th Company, 6th Marine Regiment of the United States Marines. His service in France, included battles at Belleau Wood, Château-Thierry, and Soissons. Bacon was wounded in battle. He spent time in hospital at Tours, then several months at a convalescent camp. While in recovery, he joined the camp band. His military service ended in October 1919.

After the war, Bacon returned to Baton Rouge to live with family. In 1920-21, he re-enrolled at LSU in the College of Arts and Sciences and was a band member. Bacon also joined the American Legion, Ewing Post 58. He switched to first year law at LSU in 1921-22. Records show Bacon remained in Baton Rouge for the rest of his life. Much of Bacon's photography documents buildings and places in and around Baton Rouge. His photographs depict downtown Baton Rouge, the Mississippi River, and the LSU campus. Bacon was a congregant of the First Methodist Church, and a member of the Disabled Veterans and the American Legion (1920-1974). Bacon died on 19 May 1974, and is buried at Roselawn Memorial Park and Mausoleum in Baton Rouge, Louisiana.

#### SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE

Materials in this collection contain negatives and photographs taken by Albert C. Bacon, circa 1948-1963. Photographic subjects cover downtown Baton Rouge, roads and highways, the New State Capitol, and the Mississippi River. Additional subjects include LSU campus and football games, local chemical plants and oil refineries, parades, and flooding circa 1949-1950. Negatives cover similar subjects. Images depict the buildings and streets of downtown Baton Rouge and the "Scenic Highway" section of U.S. Highway 61 in the northern part of the city. Access to negatives for research requires approval by a curator.

Writings include a 35-page account of Bacon's service as a United States Marine during World War I. Reminiscences cover his personal observations and experiences at Belleau Wood, Château-Thierry, and Soissons. Printed materials include postcards, ephemera, clippings, and publications. This includes postcards of Baton Rouge, an LSU Rodeo and Livestock Show program (1938), and LSU football tickets and schedules (1933-1962). Additional items include Delta Zeta sorority publications (1919), and a scrapbook about Huey P. Long (circa 1935).

#### **SERIES DESCRIPTIONS**

#### Series I. Photographs and Negatives, circa 1919, 1948-1963, undated

Albert C. Bacon created all the photographs and negatives in this collection. He took photographs of Baton Rouge and areas of Louisiana circa 1948-1955. Bacon often repeated imagery following patterns and revisiting the same locations. Documenting certain areas and recording the progress of construction and/or city growth seems to be of interest. Photographs are arranged in groups by subject. See the Container List for details.

Photographs were all taken in Louisiana except one aerial photograph of Paris, circa 1919. Imagery often depicts architecture, roadways, waterways, and industrial areas. Photographs of Baton Rouge feature downtown buildings, businesses, and churches. Imagery includes construction of the new Commerce Building and views of the Municipal City Park swimming pool. Subject groups include the New State Capitol, the Mississippi River, and local roads and highways. LSU related groups include campus buildings and football games. The remaining groups cover chemical plants and oil refineries, parades in New Orleans and Baton Rouge, and a flood event.

Many photographs include notation on the back detailing location and/or recollections. Several photographs were found in envelopes with negatives. These items are currently grouped within a corresponding photographic subject group. Documentation includes the original location of relocated photographs.

Negatives cover similar subjects. Most negatives depict the buildings and streets of downtown Baton Rouge and Scenic Highway. The arrangement of negatives by the photographer comprises 40 envelopes. These are the original film processing envelopes from local drugstores. Most envelopes contain notation by Bacon describing the photographic content. The envelope's film processing stamp dates the negatives. This is often more of a circa date. Envelopes are numbered 1-45, with occasional numbers missing. The arrangement is chronological by date, followed by undated items. Undated items often contain circa dates. Negatives housed in protective sleeves include the corresponding envelope numbers. Archival copies of the original envelopes are in Box 3, Folder 7. See the Appendix for negative descriptions, which includes the original envelope notation by the photographer, the existing description, and the processor's notes.

Negatives of downtown Baton Rouge feature local businesses, drugstores, department stores, shops, grocers, theaters, and gas stations. Frequent architectural subjects include the Heidelberg Hotel, Fidelity National Bank, McCrory's store, the Louisiana Trust & Savings Bank building, the Old State Capitol, and the new Commerce Building under construction. Imagery often features roads and architecture along Scenic and Airline highways. Industrial photographs depict Kaiser Aluminum plant, Copolymer Corporation rubber manufacturing plant, and Esso Standard Oil Company. Common subjects include construction sites, LSU campus, the New State Capitol, and the Mississippi River. Events covered include Mardi Gras Day on Canal Street in New Orleans (1954), the LSU Rodeo and Livestock Show, an LSU football game, and the Ice Capades. [Note: Access to negatives for research requires approval by a curator.]

#### Series II: Writings, 1916-1919

Writings include *C'est le Guerre*, a 35-page account of Bacon's service during World War I. He served with the 75th Company, 6th Regiment of the United States Marines. Observations detail his time in France from 1917 to 1919. Bacon's personal observations and experiences cover Belleau Wood, Château-Thierry, and Soissons. Writings also include recollections of pre-war experiences in New Orleans with the LSU Band. War time observations detail a measles quarantine, traveling the Paris-Metz Road to Belleau Wood, evading snipers, the lack of food, and booby-trapped gas masks. Accounts cover Bacon being wounded and his time at a hospital in Tours. Further details cover his time in a convalescent camp where he joined the band. Post war accounts cover Armistice Day celebrations, and a train wreck. He also writes of guard duty at Croix d'Hines where the U.S. Navy was building a high-powered radio station.

#### Series III: Printed Materials, 1919-1962

Printed materials include postcards, ephemera, clippings, and publications. Materials are arranged in folders by topic and media type. Bacon's scrapbook about Huey P. Long contains magazine clippings. The articles cover a range of perspectives and viewpoints about Long and his politics, circa 1935. Magazine titles represented include *Real Detective, Literary Digest, Real America, Time*, and *Liberty*. Articles of interest include a three-part editorial by Will Irwin titled "The Empire of the Kingfish."

University related materials include LSU football tickets and schedules (1933-1962). Publications include an LSU Rodeo and Livestock Show program (1938), and Delta Zeta sorority publications belonging to Bacon's sister Gladys Bacon (1919). Postcards of Baton Rouge include a miniature souvenir postcard pack (circa 1946). Imagery covers the New State Capitol, the Hotel Heidelberg, the Old Mississippi River bridge, and LSU campus. Full size postcards and ephemera (circa 1920-1958) depict LSU campus buildings, Baton Rouge hospitals, City Hall, and the Louisiana State Capitol. Postcards and ephemera include accompanying notation, often referencing Huey P. Long.
