BIOGRAPHICAL/HISTORICAL NOTE

Ronald M. Knaus was a professor at the Nuclear Science Center of Louisiana State University (LSU) in Baton Rouge, Louisiana. He was involved in the Lakes Restoration Project (also called the University Lakes Restoration Project), a partially grant funded, joint effort of the Baton Rouge City-Parish Government, LSU, and Southern University to dredge the City Park Lake and the University Lakes complex, with the purpose of addressing eutrophication, fishkills, and other deterioration affecting the lakes. Project planning and activities began in 1977, with the Institute for Environmental Studies at LSU preparing an environmental impact statement and a Section 314 grant, which was submitted to the United States Environmental Protection Agency (E.P.A.). Dredging began in November 1981, ending in May 1983. The Lakes Restoration Committee (also called the University Lakes Restoration Committee, of which Knaus served as chair) was formed to plan and guide the project, and the University Lakes Restoration Commission was formed after the project's completion to assist in monitoring lake waters and make recommendations on public access and recreational activities of the lakes.

SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE

Papers include chiefly materials related to Ronald M. Knaus's involvement in the Lakes Restoration Project, including his work as chair of the Lakes Restoration Committee. Of interest are Knaus's four binders of project records, which include correspondence, notes, memos, reports, and a variety of other records documenting the early phases and activities of the project. There are also preprint mock-ups and bound printed volumes of project quarterly reports and the project application and environmental assessment. Other materials include project proposal and grant documentation, records of the University Lakes Restoration Commission, rolled and flat plans and plan sets, maps, newspaper clippings, field books, and some photographic prints.

The remainder of the materials are reading and subject files, primarily typescripts and photocopies of land conveyances and property documents pertaining to lands around the lakes, materials from the North American Lake Management Society (NALMS), and materials pertaining to the E.P.A.'s "Clean Lakes" grant program.

SERIES DESCRIPTIONS

Series I. Lakes Restoration Project Records, 1922-1986, undated

Series includes Ronald M. Knaus's four binders of project records (1976-1981). Original order of the binders has been maintained, with them being arranged loosely in reverse chronological order. Binders contain correspondence, notes, memos, reports, studies, plans, meeting agendas and minutes, some newspaper clippings, drafts, and a variety of other records documenting early phases and activities of the project. Many of the records in these binders were used to compile the Lake Restoration Committee's quarterly reports for the project.

Materials of interest in binder 1 (1976-1977) include contact information for members of the Lakes Restoration Committee (folder 1 of 4); copies of the agreement between the Baton Rouge City-Parish Government and the Institute for Environmental Studies at LSU for the latter to prepare and submit a formal grant application to the United States E.P.A. for a Lakes Restitution Initiation Grant (folder 2 of 4); and a petition signed by LSU students, faculty, and staff urging University Administration to take an immediate and active role in dealing with the outbreak of botulism in Campus Lake (folder 4 of 4).

Materials of interest in binder 2 (1977-1978) include an aerial photograph of the lakes (EBR74-L2-60) and newspaper clippings regarding project funds and the E.P.A. grant (folder 1 of 3); a letter (March 13, 1978) from Professor Jay V. Huner of Southern University and the Lakes Restoration Committee regarding pollution in Lake Kernan (folder 2 of 3); and a transcript (October 13, 1977) of a public hearing regarding the project (folder 3 of 3).

Materials of interest in binder 3 (1978-1979) include an unbound copy of the First Quarterly Report of the University Lakes Restoration Committee (folder 1 of 5); a water quality monitoring report (August 30, 1979, folder 2 of 5); a work plan of the project (folder 3 of 5); a document regarding the proposed water quality monitoring program for the project (folder 4 of 5); and a report titled "Determination of Heavy Metal Content in University Lake Sediment" (folder 5 of 5).

Materials of interest in binder 4 (1979-1981) include proposed bathymetry drawings (January 29, 1980) of University Lake and City Park Lake (folder 1 of 3); letters from Baton Rouge citizens to Mayor W. W. [Woodrow Wilson "Woody"] Dumas regarding the project (folder 2 of 3); and a letter (October 22, 1979) from W. W. Dumas to Dr. Alvin C. Harper regarding bidding for the dredging (folder 3 of 3).

Series also includes preprint mock-ups of quarterly reports (numbered second through eighth) for the project compiled by the Lakes Restoration Committee and a preprint mock-up of the second edition of the application and environmental assessment for the project compiled by the Institute for Environmental Studies at LSU. In addition to these preprint mock-ups, there are also bound printed copies of the seventh and eight quarterly reports and the first and second editions of the application and environmental assessment. These materials contain correspondence, studies, financial and budget documents, planning documents, data on water and algal monitoring, and other records documenting the period leading to the dredging of the lakes. Additional materials in the series include: files pertaining to the project proposal and grant agreement and extension, which are mostly working copies of agreements and applications with some correspondence; progress reports of the project, including one on sediment characterization by R. P. Gambrell (August 3, 1977); a separate file of newspaper clippings documenting the project and the use of the lakes; three hydro survey field books (1977); a separate file of records of the University Lakes Restoration Commission, consisting mostly of meeting minutes, agendas, and correspondence; photographic prints (undated), mostly of unidentified people at the lakes; some financial materials; and other assorted project records, including a post dredging water quality monitoring program report conducted from September 1, 1982 to December 31, 1984 (stored in Assorted Project Records folder).
