BIOGRAPHICAL/HISTORICAL NOTE

The Louisiana Environmental Action Network (LEAN) was founded to help citizens in developing, implementing, protecting, and enforcing legislative and regulatory environmental standards. The network consists of 106 member groups and over 1700 individual members. Working together, LEAN campaigns to decrease pollution and water contamination, give technical assistance to groups preparing for permit hearings, and inform the community of environmental and public health issues.

SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE

Permit applications submitted by various companies to the Louisiana Department of Environmental Quality. Collection also contains incomplete lawsuit records documenting conflicts between the Department of Environmental Quality and Marine Shale Processors, Inc. and Rollins Environmental Services, Inc. Future accruals are expected.

I. Permit Applications, 1986-1998 (13.5 linear feet)

Applications submitted by various companies to the Louisiana DEQ for permission to build hazardous waste storage facilities, construct landfills, treat and dispose of chemical waste, and emit pollutants into the air and/or water. Records consist of certification letters, narrative reports, forms, maps and diagrams, and responses to permit deficiencies.

Permit Applications were originally housed in binders. Sections of the applications were separated by tabbed index dividers. The arrangement of the materials within the folders reflects the original arrangement of documents within those binders and dividers. Permit applications have been arranged alphabetically by company submitting the permit and alphabetically and chronologically therein by name of plant, if applicable. Some chapters of permit applications were not accessioned because they were not required by the DEQ.

Oversize items with dimensions less than 38" x 50" are located in boxes 14-20. Items larger than 38" x 50" are housed in the gray map case in the map cage.
